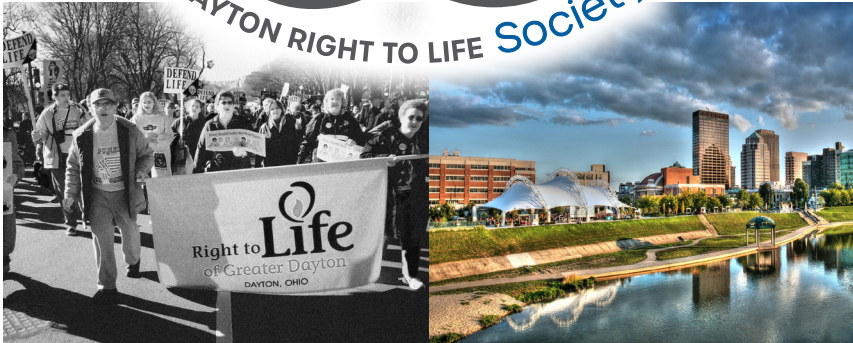

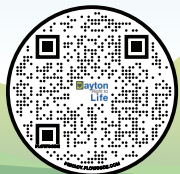

BREAKING NEWS

On Friday, April 15th, Hamilton County Court Judge Hathaway blocked Ohio's new law that prohibited publicly funded university employees from signing onto an abortion-provider's variance agreement.

Pro-Life Gridlock

This April will mark the 3rd anniversary of Governor DeWine's signing of the “Heartbeat Bill” into law in 2019. In July 2019, the law was blocked from being enacted by U.S District Court Judge Michael Barret. Ironically, it was U.S. Senator Mike DeWine who supported and recommended Barrett's nomination in 2006 in a speech on the Senate floor. The “Heartbeat” law is still languishing in Judge Barrett's court, with little action by the DeWine administration to move it forward.

Other pro-life laws stifled in court include:

- **Born Alive Act** passed in 2021—currently in Hamilton County Court
- **Fetal Remains Disposition Act** passed in 2021—currently in Hamilton County Court
- **Telemed Health prohibition in chemical abortion** passed in 2021—currently in Hamilton County Court
- **Ambulatory Surgical Facility restrictions** passed in 2015—currently in Federal court

Help Needed

Too often, we hear that Dayton Right to Life's focus is mostly about changing laws regarding life. Truth is, we are about so much more than that. While the Dayton Right to Life Society focuses on legislation, the Dayton Right to Life Foundation is much more than a small fraction of what DRTL is all about. The Foundation is in place to service children in need, educate families, and provide scholarships for parents who have chosen life.

Our Stork's Nest Baby Pantry services children from newborn to five years. Through the pantry, families may obtain clothing, toiletries, formula, diapers, and much more. In 2021, we serviced an average of 155 children per month.

In December, the unthinkable happened when we ran out of clothing from sizes 2T-5T. Families rely on our pantry to help them clothe their children and we actually had to turn away toddlers for two months because there was simply nothing to give. It is our mission to not let that happen ever again, but there is no way to reach that goal without the generosity of our community.

You may help by getting your church, business, or charitable organization involved in our "Just One Month" program. With this program, your organization signs up for one month of the year to gather a collection of items to be donated to the Stork's Nest Baby Pantry. You decide the length of time within the month to gather the items, we provide you a list of most needed items, and you call us when it is ready for pick-up. It is that easy!

We ask that you prayerfully consider participating in this ministry. It will relieve so many families of burdens that many times we take for granted. Being pro-life is not just about saving babies from abortion. It is also about caring for them for the years after they are born. Please help us to help every child who comes through our door.

- **We're hiring for the Stork's Nest Baby Pantry.** We are looking for an organized, compassionate person with a giving heart to assist families in need with diapers, clothing, formula, and other necessities for their children. Other duties include coordinating volunteers, scheduling appointments, and processing donations. Hours are Tuesday through Friday, 9 A.M. - 4 P.M.
- **DRTL is seeking volunteers to assist in the Stork's Nest Baby Pantry.** Duties may include scheduling appointments, stocking the pantry, and assisting clients. Various shifts are available.
- **A Spanish translator is needed to assist with phone calls and appointments.** If you, or someone you know, is interested in volunteering and speaks fluent Spanish, please contact our office.
- **Calling all churches! We are looking for another church to join Victory Christian Church to be an offsite baby pantry, also known as a mobile pantry.** It is a commitment of one Saturday a month for only a few hours. The mobile pantry is important to assist families who cannot make it to the onsite baby pantry due to work or other obligations during our office hours.
- **We are currently collecting backpacks and school supplies** for school age children and **books for infants through Pre-K** for our Back-to-School Community Event in August.

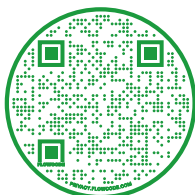
